

2024/25 FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in FC Arizona. In order to assess whether you qualify for financial aid, you need to Fill out the attached form. The Club can provide aid in certain circumstances based on the team that the player is on.

There are four types of costs involved in Club soccer. Below is a description of each with a note about whether it can potentially be covered.

- 1. **Registration Fee.** This goes to the State and cannot be covered by the Club.
- 2. **Training Fee.** This goes to the Club to pay for coaches, fields, lights, equipment, etc. This can be covered in full or in part by financial aid.
- 3. **Uniform Kit.** Our kits are usually on a two-year cycle and cannot be paid for by financial aid.
- 4. **Team Fees.** This includes the costs of league fees, referees fees, tournaments and possible team travel. Typically, the Club does not cover these costs, but in some cases, the Club can work out a situation related to the team.

How does the process work?

First, fill out the Financial Aid Form on the following pages and submit with them two years of tax filings (2023 and 2024, if you haven't filed 2024 yet, then 2023 and 2022).

Register with your team, which means paying the Registration Fee.

The Club will review your application and reach out to you within 30 days of application.
